1 : After presenting "Hors des sentiers battus" in 2015 and then "Toto et ses sœurs" last year, Morgane Pichot will present the latest film by Cristian Mungiu, one of the key-directors of what is called the Rumanian New Wave, who was awarded the Palme d'Or at Cannes in 2007 for "4 mois, 3 semaines et 2 jours". At that time Morgane Pichot was studying cinema at Lyon University and decided to specialize in the Rumanian cinema for two years and in particular the period 1989-2009, the subject of her Master's thesis."

2 : A story which affected a great number of German families: from 1947 to 1960, 1.4 million German prisoners-of-war returned home from Russia after the Second World War. Sönke Wortmann's film describes how one family awaits the return of one of its members retained in Russia. It is at that precise moment that the German football team - contrary to everyone's expectations - carries off the World Cup in Bern by beating the prestigious Hungarian team. At the end of the screening Hans Herth who was president of the FFA (Federation of Franco-German Associations) and whose father returned from Russia in 1952 will talk about these reunions from a personal angle - reunions which for some families proved painful.

3 : Guest speaker : Thiermo DIA, specialist in African cinema, lecturer in Comparative Cinema at the universities of Bordeaux and Niamey.



## PRENDRE LE LARGE


