

Depart from the community hall in Montmorency-Beaufort.

① Facing of the Community Hall, turn left along "Rue Principale".



② At the town hall, turn left into "Rue du Mai Gallus" and go straight ahead.



③ At the end of the street, follow the footpath on the right and go along the castle moat.



④ At the end of the footpath turn right and go straight ahead.



⑤ At the crossroads, turn right along the track and go downhill.



⑥ In order to admire the panorama, climb up the footpath on the left.




⑦ Go back down the footpath to where you last turned off and carry straight across taking the footpath in front of you. Go around the water tower on the right and carry on straight ahead.

⑧ Turn right and follow the GR footpath. Then turn left into Rue Haute leading to Rue Principale.

⑨ Turn left along Rue Principale and then take the footpath on the right.



⑩ At the cross-road, take the footpath on the left and follow it until you meet the road where you turn right.



⑪ Take the first track on the left and follow it until you meet the 'La Voire' river.

⑫ At the river, turn right along the grassy footpath and then follow the stone track on the right until you reach the road.



⑬ At the road junction turn left towards the village.

⑭ In the village take the dirt track on the right and then take the left fork to return to the car park.



Code of Conduct

- Keep to the marked footpath.
- Take your litter at home.
- Respect wildlife, livestock and crops.
- Keep your dog on a lead.
- Never light a fire in the forest.
- Be vigilante and diplomatic during the hunting season.
